Let us build our lives on the sure rock of this Word!



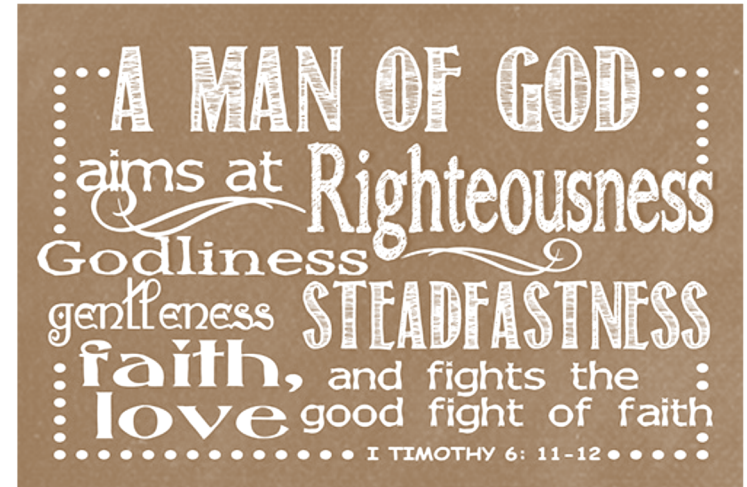
