Camp Policies

- I agree to make all payments in full prior to the start of camp each week.
- I understand a \$20.00 **NON-REFUNDABLE** deposit must be made for each week of camp your child is registered for camp. The deposit will be deducted from the weekly fee. The deposit will NOT be returned in your child does NOT attend camp for the chosen week.
- I understand that my child must be registered one full week prior to chosen camp week and payment must be made in full on the first day of camp.
- I understand my child will not be able attend if payment is not received prior to the start of each week.
- I understand that my child will be expected to participate in the activities provided. If child is not participating and being disruptive, parents will be notified.
- I understand bullying will not be tolerated.
- Campers should dress appropriately for activities each day, including sunscreen and sneakers.
- Campers should bring a labeled water bottle each day that can be refilled as needed.
- Lunch will be from 12-1 each day. Lunch and snack are not provided. Occasionally, lunch may be offered at a cost...please watch for information.
- Pretzels will be sold each Tuesday for \$1 as a fundraiser for camp extras.
- After lunch the children will participate in activities such as board games, crafts, playing outside or in the computer lab.
